### **Update - Notification for Connection to the IGS Monitoring System**

As detailed in our correspondence to all venues on 19 April, you are requested to provide your Venue's Notification to IGS and the VCGLR by **18 May 2012**. The information you are requested to provide is to reflect the Available Gaming Machines on your Venue's gaming floor as at 16 August 2012.

Intralot Gaming Services (IGS) understands that both Tabcorp and Tattersalls have now issued Gaming Machine details for EGMs purchased from them (or where they have facilitated the purchase of the Gaming Machines). Venues can use the data provided by the Gaming Operators to populate Annexure C. The Gaming Operators have provided proxies for some of the requested fields. IGS will accept these proxies on the Notification. In the case of Gaming Machines purchased directly from the Gaming Machine Manufacturers, please use the information provided by them to populate the templates.

3. Connection Annexure D

It is important to note that if your Notification is received by IGS after:

- 18 May 2012, but before 16 August 2012, your Venue's Available Gaming Machines will be connected within 28 days from 16 August 2012.
- 16 August 2012, your gaming machines will be connected within 28 days of the date of the Notification.
